What is Peace, Joy, and Righteousness? 11-30-18

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There is an enormous misunderstanding in the Christian world and IDMR about the divine principles of Peace, Joy, and Righteousness and the purpose of Yahweh Elohim prophesied by the Law and Prophets and repeated in our Present Kingdom Age of Grace. Using the law and the prophets and the tabernacle pattern will clear up this misunderstanding.

Rom. 14:17 "For the Kingdom of God is not meat and drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Ghost."

Here are some definitions from the internet of Peace, Joy, and Righteousness.

Peace - noun

- 1 freedom from disturbance; quiet and tranquility
 - mental calm; serenity: the **peace of mind** this insurance gives you.

2 a state or period in which there is no war or a war has ended: the Straits were to be open to warships in time of peace | [in singular]: the peace didn't last.

- [in singular] a treaty agreeing to the cessation of war between warring states: support for a negotiated peace.
- freedom from civil disorder: police action to restore peace.
- freedom from dispute or dissension between individuals or groups: the 8.8 percent offer that promises peace with the board.

Joy - noun

a feeling of great pleasure and happiness: tears of joy | the joy of being alive.

• a thing that causes joy: the joys of Manhattan.

verb [no object] literary

rejoice: I felt shame that I had ever joyed in his discomfiture or pain.

Righteousness - noun

the quality of being morally right or justifiable: we had little doubt about the righteousness of our cause | conviction of his own moral righteousness gave his oratory an irresistible power.

The following examples will show that Peace, Joy, and Righteousness In the kingdom of Yahweh cannot be established until iniquity is cast down.

Yahweh Elohim called His Son out of Egypt (Hos. 11:1; Matt. 2:15) while devastating Egypt with the last seven plagues. The Israelites were spared from Yahweh's wrath by partaking of the Paschal Lamb and putting the blood on their doors, so they had peace from the wrath of Yahweh while they were in Goshen. They came thru the divided waters of the Red Sea and resurrected, while Pharaoh and his host were cast down.

What did Pharaoh have to do with Peace, Joy, and Righteousness? The casting down of Pharaoh in the Red Sea established Peace, Joy, and Righteousness for Israel. This is repeated with Jehu when the Baal worshipers of Jezebel asked him did he come in peace and he responded how can there be peace when witchcraft, idolatry and sorcery abound (2 Kings

9:22). Peace can only be established when wickedness and idolatry are cast down which was done in heaven with Lucifer and his host first.

Peace, Joy, and Righteousness were manifested with the Israelites when they were in a type of the resurrected state in the Holy Place/Wilderness. Moses and Israel sang a song of victory so this is the joy or rejoicing.

Righteousness is defined as having the lamb in them which gave Israel peace from the wrath of Yahweh (Ex.15:1-2) The attributes of Peace, Joy, and Righteousness define the kingdom of Yahweh when Israel was delivered from Egypt. "Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the Lord, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the Lord, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. 2 The Lord is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him."

The state of mind of Peace, Joy, and Righteousness exists with the holy spirit in the resurrection and was manifested and repeated many times throughout the prophets.

Now the Messiah referred to peace many times with His disciples. Then in the 24th chapter Matthew, He appears to contradict the peaceful state he promised them by saying there shall be wars, rumors of wars, famines, earthquakes in divers places, deceptions, pestilences and even that He would be evilly entreated, crucified and resurrected the third day and the disciples would be prosecuted and killed for His name sake.

How could His disciples not be troubled with such dire prophecies? Is the Messiah double minded or maybe confused in what He said of peace?

Yahshua did make some clarification on what He meant by His peace. He says, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27)."

Clearly, there are two types of peace; a peace of this world and Yahshua's peace.

Peace of this world is defined as temporary peace between warring nations, as stated above. But in terms of Yahweh if you are not in harmony with the purpose of Elohim, you can't be at peace or you are enmity against Yahweh. For example, offering up carnal ordinances in the Dispensation of Grace is being ignorant/devoid of the purpose of Yahweh where you are saved by grace through faith, not of works. So they are fearful and afraid of prophecies that were and will come, not understanding the purpose of what was prophesied. For example, Pilate's wife told him that she had a dream about Yahshua being a good man and she was fearful of him. Pilate found no fault in the Messiah, but was forced by the Jews to sentence him to death to fulfill the prophecy of the Messiah being put to death.

"When he was set down on the judgment seat, his wife sent unto him, saying, Have thou nothing to do with that just man: for I have suffered many things this day in a dream because of him."— Matthew 27:19 (KJV)

Clearly, the peace Yahshua the Messiah referred to is a peace of mind which is being in harmony with the purpose of Yahweh. This means an understanding of the Messiah in you is essential for not being fearful of events purposed/prophesied (testimony of Yahshua is the spirit of prophecy Rev. 19:10) by Elohim in the earth plane, such as His death, burial, resurrection, the persecution of disciples and believers, and the destruction of the Herodian Temple.

For example, He told His own disciples that He would be crucified and resurrect the third day. They were with Him in His ministry, saw many miracles, and performed miracles themselves under the auspices of the Holy Spirit.

Yet when the event occurred, they all denied it, were fearful of the Jews, and had no Peace, Joy, and Righteousness

Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary, the mother of James, and other women went to the tomb to embalm the body of Yahshua showing they didn't believe in His resurrection (Lk. 24:1-12). When the Angels told them to tell the disciples the grave was empty and the Messiah had risen, the disciples didn't believe the women. They didn't have any Peace, Joy, and Righteousness until Pentecost which enabled them to withstand the persecution of the religious leaders.

Now if these principles repeat themselves over and over again thru the ages a question should be asked to all those who walked with Dr. Henry C. Kinley. Did they really have the divine understanding of what he was saying?

Now the Apostle John was the last apostle alive in AD 96, held over in the Present Kingdom Age to write the book of Revelation, which contains the purpose of Yahweh from beginning to end. He spoke or wrote of a prophecy in this age, which very few understand.

The Apostle John in Revelation prophesied of the destruction of Mystery Babylon's financial system which means a world wide depression and bankruptcy of banks, corporations and nations. This means the guy in the street will lose all his worldly possessions: his paycheck, pension, and home. Money (all paper monies) will fail as they did in Joseph's time. (Gen. 47:15).

Many will be fearful of homelessness, famine, and pestilence (the four horsemen/first four seals Rev. 6th chap). There will be riots in the streets, possible civil wars and definitely no Peace, Joy, and Righteousness. However, let not your hearts be troubled (John 14:1, 27).

Finally, the destruction of the city Rome that sits on seven hills, or the beast with the ten horns, burning the whore in the 17th Chapter of Revelation, will soon occur. These prophecies are required for salvation as John states below.

Rev. 1:1-3 **1** "The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John: **2** Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw. **3** Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand. ..."

Rev. 22:18-21 **18** "For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: **19** And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. **20** He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus. **21** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen."

My question to you is what did Pilate, the Pharisees and Saduccess have to do with Peace, Joy, and Righteousness? Many will say nothing. However, they were ignorantly fulfilling the

purpose of Yahweh by instigating Yahshua Messiah's death and persecuting His disciples. Without them, there could be no crucifixion and resurrection of the Messiah or fulfilling of the scriptures which established the Kingdom of Yahweh: Peace, Joy, and Righteousness.

What did the US Presidents (including Trump 45th) have to do with Peace, Joy, and Righteousness?

Understanding the presidents according to the pattern in our Present Kingdom Age is a repetition of the Messiah's prophecies (Daniel and Revelation) which gives us faith that His purpose is up to date.

Today, what do Russian President Vladimir Putin, Pope Francis of the Roman Catholic Church, China President Xi Jinping, and President Donald Trump and others world leaders have to do with Peace, Joy, and Righteousness referred to by the Messiah?

They must fulfill the prophecy in the book of Revelations: the beast burning the whore, the bankruptcies of their countries (which Dr. Kinley prophesied in the introduction of the textbook) and the total collapse of their economies, Babylon Fallen !!! (Rev. 18th chap).

This is the casting down of the Luciferian Kingdom in this world as there was a war in heaven (Rev. 12:7-8). Satan was also cast down through the ages with Noah and Yahshua the Messiah. (Note: Read the paper entitled "3 Ages Ending in Accordance with the Archetypal

Pattern Of the Universe: The Book of Revelation reveals the End of TechnoBabylon")

The fall of Babylon will establish the New Heaven and New Earth State, which is peace, joy and righteous in the kingdom. Those that have the kingdom of Yahweh within will be placed in a New Earth State.

Now the Apostle John describes in his vision Yahshua's righteous and the marriage of the Lamb. He writes what is the righteous.

Rev 19:1-2 "And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Yahweh Elohim: **2** For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand."

Here is the righteousness of Yahweh. In the marriage of Yahshua/Lamb to His bride is the joy and peace

9 "Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. **8** And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints."

In conclusion, these examples in the law, prophets and fulfillment with Yahshua prove without a shadow of a doubt that one with Peace, Joy, and Righteousness is in harmony with the purpose of Yahweh including all the prophecies as stated by the Apostle John in Revelation.
